

Marvin Barish Right Start Frequently Asked Questions

Question	Answer
We have one child and we are applying for a Jewish infant care program for the first time. How does Marvin Barish Right Start work?	If a child is the first in a family to attend a Jewish early childhood program, that child is eligible for the Marvin Barish Right Start Signature Voucher (if you are enrolling in Infant care, please wait for your child to be born): -\$1,000 if the child attends 2/3 days/week; -\$2,000 if the child attends 5 days/week.
What happens if I have multiples in my immediate family and would like to enroll more than one child simultaneously for the first time?	Families with twins/multiples are eligible for one signature voucher for the first child and a sibling voucher of \$500 for each additional child.
We just moved to the Houston area from out of state/another country, where my child attended a Jewish preschool program. Is my child eligible for the voucher?	Unfortunately, your child is not eligible because he/she has attended a Jewish preschool previously. Eligibility for the voucher is based on the first child of a family attending Jewish preschool for the first time, independent of location.
My child is entering kindergarten. Is she eligible for the voucher?	A child entering kindergarten is not eligible. The child needs to be enrolling in an infant, toddler, or preschool program.
